The United States Department of Labor classifies a nontraditional occupation as one in which individuals preparing for that field are on a career path to an occupation that generally employs less than 20 percent of a specific gender. For female nontraditional careers, less than 20 percent of individuals employed are female; likewise, male nontraditional careers employ

less than 20 percent males.
